
IV. NPDES Individual Permit Applications for Stormwater Discharges from MS4s

The application is for a renewal of an individual NPDES permit for the discharge of stormwater from a regulated municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to waters of the Commonwealth in Easton City, Northampton County. The receiving stream(s), Bushkill Creek (HQ-CWF, MF), Lehigh River (WWF, MF), and the Delaware River (WWF, MF), are located in State Water Plan watersheds 2-C and 1-F and are classified for High Quality-Cold Water and Migratory Fish (Bushkill Creek), and Warm Water and Migratory Fish (Lehigh River and Delaware River), aquatic life, water supply and recreation. The applicant is classified as a small MS4.

The applicant has submitted the following plan(s) with the application to reduce pollutant loads to impaired waters:

- A Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP)

The Department has made a tentative determination to issue the NPDES permit. Written comments on the application and draft permit will be accepted for 30 days following publication of this notice. The period for comment may be extended at the discretion of DEP for one additional 15-day period.
