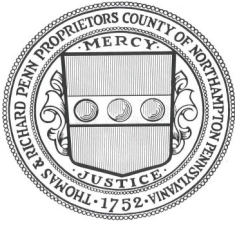


# Northampton County

Aerosols	Herbicides/pesticides	Thermometers
Antifreeze	Household cleaners	Thermostats
Automotive fluids & cleaners	Mercury-containing products	
Batteries (all types)	Motor oil/filters	
Compressed gas	Oil-based paint & stains	
Fluorescent light bulbs	Old gasoline/oil mixtures	
Flammables/combustibles	Pool chemicals	

**No TVs or other electronics accepted**

**Non-hazardous materials will not be accepted**

**No latex paint or stains**

**No smoke detectors/radioactives**

### Accepted Scrap Metals

Recycling of residential scrap, that is primarily metal, including lawn furniture, vehicle rims/wheels, yard equipment (oil, gas & batteries removed), major metal appliances (washer, dryers, stoves), air conditioners and dehumidifiers (refrigerant does not require removal, it will be recycled), etc.
